Anesthesia/Surgery Authorization

Most of us are concerned about the safety of anesthesia and the surgery that is performed on our pets. Your doctor will do a thorough examination on your pet prior to anesthesia today. In addition to the physical exam, we would like to screen for internal problems that we cannot detect on the physical exam. We advise a general health screen of internal organ function by drawing a small amount of blood from your pet. The doctor will review these lab results prior to anesthesia.

Save an additional \$10 by bringing your pet in early for the "Adult Health Screen". Total cost with savings is \$49.
